Guidelines:

- Applicants must be full-time high school students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher and an ACT score of 22 or higher.
- Applications are evaluated with equal emphasis on academic achievement, community service and essay content.
- Awards are payable to the student upon proof of enrollment.
- The applicant must be a member of Consumers Credit Union.

Application Materials:

- Completed and signed Scholarship Application.
- High school transcript and ACT test score documentation for high school applicants.
- Letter of acceptance from an accredited college or university.
- Letter of recommendation.
- Additional supporting documentation to demonstrate participation in school activities and/or community service of benefit to others.
- Typed essay (300-500 words) addressing the theme *"Explain a challenge or event in your life that has changed your future."*
