New earlier deadline for Medicare Annual Election Period: October 15 - December 7, 2011.

KALAMAZOO, MICH — Consumers Credit Union is working with the Marvin Okun Insurance Agency to present these timely and informative seminars, ***Understanding Your Medicare Options***, which explain the sometimes complicated choices faced by seniors or children assisting their aging parents.

There will be a 45-minute informational session to be held at Consumers Credit Union, and presented by Robert Williams, a Certified Insurance Counselor. Williams is a licensed life and health insurance agent familiar with Medicare programs who also offers a breadth of experience and depth of knowledge on many wide-ranging (and often confusing) Medicare topics. An additional 45-minute Q&A session will immediately follow his presentation.

Attendees will learn about the choices Medicare provides; what Medicare covers and what it doesn't; how coverage can be supplemented; and the different coverage options Medicare provides (including Parts A, B, C, & D). Also to be discussed and new for this year is the earlier deadline for the Medicare Annual Election Period: October 15-December 7, 2011.
